COVID 19 Operating Guidelines

Fortress Mountain Resort (FMR) / KPOW Cat Skiing recognises the community effort that is required to prevent the spread of this damaging virus. This document will detail actions being taken by FMR / KPOW both internally and in regard to guests visiting the site for the winter season of 2020 / 2021.

These guidelines have been developed after discussion with KPOW's two medical directors, reference to current Alberta Health Services (AHS) guidelines, and to act within industry standard practices.

The safety and health of both guests and staff at Fortress are of the highest priority and will remain as such above all other considerations. These guidelines will be adjusted, if/when required, to accommodate the rapidly evolving issues that are presented with the COVID 19 response. Patience and understanding from all will be critical and is appreciated as we work to navigate this complex issue while still enjoying some great skiing! This current revision is to reflect the most recent requirements as detailed by AHS on December 8, 2020 and are in effect until January 12, 2021 at which time revisions will be made should restrictions / recommendations be altered.

To eliminate the potential of confusion, the following practices will be implemented for guests and staff at all times:

Pre-screening

A pre-screening questionnaire will be required from every guest prior to their access to the Fortress site. This questionnaire is required to be completely filled out on each individual visit and includes: name, contact details, date of visit, purpose of visit, assessment question list, and acknowledgement. A copy of this questionnaire will be sent to each guest prior to arrival. The pre-screening questionnaire will be kept of file for a duration of 14 days post visit and will only be used for reference should contact tracing actions be required. (copy attached below for reference)

Indoor Spaces

As per AHS requirements, all indoor spaces will be closed to public access. Individual access can be provided in the event of first aid requirement, warming, etc. Our washroom unit will remain open with regular sanitization and hand sanitizer available.

Group Sizes

For this period of restriction, cat skiing group sizes will be limited to 10 guests. Guests are encouraged to book within cohort / family groups if possible.

Face Covering

A face covering that covers at minimum the mouth and nose will be required to be worn:

- when physical distancing of a minimum of 2 meters can not be maintained
- in the KPOW transport van
- while loading / unloading the KPOW snowcat (including loading / unloading of equipment)
- while inside the KPOW snowcat
- while inside the KPOW Lounge or any other building (for staff, public access is restricted at this time)

Physical Distancing

Participation in achieving physical distancing of no less than 2 meters whenever possible will be required by all. This will include when participating in morning safety briefings and in recurring run briefings. When physical distancing can not be maintained, face coverings are required.

Seating

Guests will be requested to utilize the same seats inside the snowcat and to seat themselves beside the guests that they arrived with. While it has been a fun experience in the past, guest will no longer be able to ride in the front cab of the snowcat with the operator.

Ventilation

Ventilation of transport vehicles will be increased as much as reasonably possible.

KPOW Cancellation

Should a guest need to cancel their booking due to a COVID related issue, they will be provided the ability to transfer their booking to another day in the season at no charge or to transfer their booking to another person. KPOW will work with guests to find acceptable solutions should a workable transfer date not be possible due to lack of availability on a case by case basis.

Food Service

All food services will work to eliminate opportunities for cross contamination. This will include direct service by FMR/KPOW staff (versus the past 'buffet' style of morning / lunch service) and the requirement to utilize a new disposable dish should 'seconds' be needed. KPOW will operate with additional seating benches at our outdoor lunch sites to allow for better spacing of guests. Snacks and water will be individual portions and distributed by KPOW staff when requested (versus our past 'help yourself' system). Plastic water bottles will not be used, FMR will provide water in aluminum cans.

Staffing

Staff will be scheduled as much as possible to remain in working cohort groups and will be required to complete the pre-screening questionnaire at the start of every shift. Staff are required to wear face coverings in staff rooms and at all times when indoors / physical distancing can't be maintained. Staff will travel in the front of the snowcat or via snowmobile. Household, cohort, or individual travel to/from work is also encouraged.

Sanitization

Increased sanitization frequency will occur in all areas of the operation. This will include (but not be limited to) the 'KPOW Lounge', the KPOW transport van, toilet facility, the KPOW snowcat, and staff rooms. Hand sanitizer will be provided at numerous locations throughout the operation including multiple locations in the 'KPOW Lounge', multiple locations in the KPOW transport van, in the toilet facility, and in the KPOW snowcat. A sink for handwashing remains available in the 'KPOW Lounge'. All vehicles and common areas will be sanitized at the end of each operating day using our recently acquired Victory Electrostatic Sprayer and Vital Oxide Sanitizer.
